Scholarship Requirements and Clarifications

- 1) THE GREEN SCHOLARSHIP is a single-session, full scholarship awarded by the NEMC Board of Advisors to a qualifying instrumental major. Applicants can be either new or returning campers. (Previous winners of the Green Scholarship are not eligible to re-apply.)
 - a. A single-session full scholarship includes tuition, room, and board for one of two three-week sessions (June/July) or (July/August) The Applicant is responsible for any and all travel expenses and personal spending money.
 - b. A qualifying instrumental major is defined as a camper taking two [2] or more instrumental lessons per week while at NEMC. He/she is expected to participate fully in the instrumental program while at Camp.
- 2) Applicant must submit a YouTube video consisting of two [2] contrasting pieces that best represent the applicant's ability (musicianship, tone, range, etc). Please refer to the YouTube video upload instructions found on the NEMC audition requirements page.
 - a. Video audition must include appropriate accompaniments.
 - b. The applicant should announce the titles and composers of his/her composition on the video.
- 3) Applications and video links must be received on or before March 15th.
- 4) The Instrumental Scholarship Committee, in consultation with a representative from the Board of Advisors, will listen to the recordings, examine the application materials, and make the final decisions based upon merit and/or Camp instrumentation requirements. The winner will be contacted on or around April 1st.
- 5) Scholarship recipients may be interviewed, recorded, and/or photographed for future use by NEMC.
